### Requisition Order (Revised) Under The Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897

By virtue of power vested in me under section-2 (ii) as 'Authorized Person' vide above said notification, and section 11 (vii) read with section 12, I hereby declare, 07 Hospital/extension in Segment I & 01 Hospital/extension in Segment II as per Annexure-1, as "Designated COVID-19 Hospitals" for isolation of cases for COVID-19 for Vadodara Municipal Corporation and Vadodara District.

"SETU" – Association of Private Hospitals and Private Practitioners and Indian Medical Association, Vadodara had jointly submitted a proposal for designating 500 beds and a Notification PRO No. 141 dated 31/05/2020 was issued subsequent to it.

The Hospitals designated in the First phase were reviewed for adherence to protocols and standards of care. The number of hospitals and beds required has been reviewed and it has been decided to increase the number of beds in both segments (Segment I – Healthcare facilities without ICU facilities and Segment II – Large corporate level infrastructure with ICU facility) as per Annexure 1.

This order will be effective from 10<sup>th</sup>April 2021 and till further notice by the undersigned.

The Schedule of rates is as prescribed in **Notification PRO No. 299 dated 15/7/2020 (Annexure 2)** and **Annexure 3** for Inclusion/exclusion criteria.

Further, following conditions shall apply:

No Private Hospital within the Requisition Order Under The Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897

- 1. VMC or Vadodara District limit, whether designated or not as COVID-19 Hospital, is permitted to charge above the ceiling rates prescribed in the schedule at Annexure-2.
- 2. Doctors, Nurses & Paramedical Staff will continue to discharge their duties at the same hospital/work place as before. No change in hospital/work place is allowed without prior permission of VMC or District Authorities.

Medical Officer of Health in VMC area and Chief District Health Officer in Vadodara District will execute an agreement with the hospitals listed in Annexure-1. Any person / Institution / organization found violating any provision of these regulations shall be deemed to have committed punishable offence under section 188 of Indian Penal Code (45 of 1860).

### Rates Include:

- 1. Two Meals, Breakfast, Evening tea and snacks.
- 2. Cost of PPE Kits, N-95 masks and all medicines except those mentioned above.

**Note** - The visit fees of doctors under the category "Special Doctor" will apply only to the visits of specific super specialists like Nephrologist, Cardiologist, etc. It would not apply to the in – house medical officer, intensivist, and physician.

#### NOTE:

- All the above services, inclusion and exclusion are for Ward, HDU, ICU and ICU with ventilator category patients admitted in General area.
- Patients opting for higher categories will be charged as per Hospital COVID 19 Schedule of Charges (SOC). Hospital will have to take written consent from patient/relative for higher category admissions.
  - o All regular charges of the hospital as per their SOC shall apply in all such cases.
  - Hospitals will clearly mention the higher category room charges/packages and additional charges, if any, on letter-head at the time of consent.
  - o No disputes raised shall be entertained in cases where a written consent for higher category rooms/services has been given by patient or their relative.
- Insurance Companies shall give approvals within 6 hours of e-submission of bills.
- All deductions made by the Insurance Companies will have to be paid by the patient.
- Insurance Companies shall process the claims within 7 days of submission of necessary documents.
- Hospitals will have to provide bills with necessary break-up of charges claimed as per the requirement and in accordance with IRDA regulations.
